

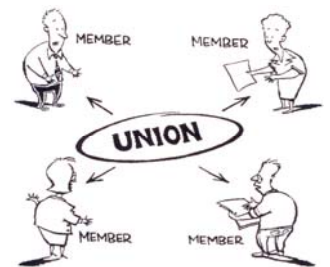
MEDICAL IMAGING NEWSLETTER

The Health Services Union received correspondence from Department of Health on 8th May 2008 – *"Subject: Medical Imaging Central Classification Panel"* (copy attached).

At the meeting held last Thursday night (8th May 2008) attended by over 80 radiographers, the department's response to our members concerns as per our motion passed on 16th April 2008 was discussed. After thorough and enthusiastic discussions, the following motion was passed:

"That this meeting of the public sector radiographers instructs the Health Services Union (HSU) to arrange a meeting with the Department of Health to discuss our concerns as per our motion of the 16th April 2008. This meeting is to be held within the next ten (10) days.



Furthermore, that the meeting be attended by a HSU representative, plus three (03) Radiographers nominated by members.

If the HSU & Radiographer delegation are not satisfied with the negotiations with the Department of Health; tonight's meeting also instructs the HSU to implement industrial action as determined by our second resolution"

We encourage you to nominate a representative of your local department to be part of the negotiating team to the mentioned meeting.

A meeting has been arranged with Mr Patrick Smith (DoH) for Friday 23rd May 2008.
