

MEDICAL IMAGING NEWSLETTER

27 November 2008

On Wednesday 26 November 2008, radiographers from CNAHS and the Health Services Union met to discuss the lack of response from the Panel regarding the assessment of the Chief Radiographer position.

At the meetings, the following motion was unanimously passed:

- 1 Allow immediate implementation of the approved medical imaging positions**
- 2 Support the request made by CNAHS HR for the panel to provide particulars related to the decision making process for the Chief Radiographer position. Furthermore, express our disappointment and lack of confidence in the panel for their failure to provide information in the timely manner as requested by CNAHS HR**
- 3 Demand that DoH provide the particulars related to the decision making process for the Chief Radiographer position by Friday 28 November 2008.**
- 4 If this information is not forthcoming by Friday 28 November 2008, an industrial dispute will be declared.**

Just after 6pm on Wednesday 26 Nov 08, the HSU received response from DoH, confirming that the position has been classified at a level 4. They provided explanation on how the panel arrived to this decision. The HSU will consult with Chief Radiographers and CNAHS, we'll keep you informed.
