A telephone conference of radiographer's representatives was held on Friday 10 Oct 08 to assess correspondence from SA Health—HR Workforce Development Unit (copy attached).

After a lengthy discussion, the meeting agreed that SA Health has addressed the deadline as put by the radiographers' motion in September 2008.

That is, in relation to the submissions made to the Central Panel in July 2008, the panel has assessed all positions.

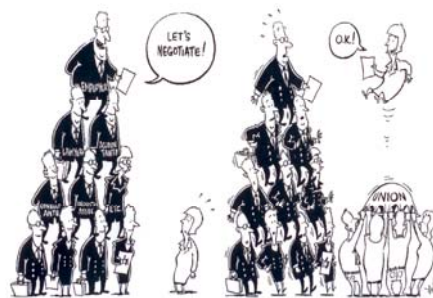
During the meeting, the HSU received verbal confirmation that the Breast Screen SA's submission was also completed. The meeting then determined:

- **“that members at The Queen Elizabeth Hospital, Lyell McEwin Hospital, Royal Adelaide Hospital and Breast Screen SA will suspend industrial action until further notice,**
- **and that the classification levels for all positions as assessed by the panel be provided by Tuesday 14 October 2008”.**

Please note that the correspondence from the department stated *“it is acknowledged that CNAHS may in future wish to provide further submission in respect of certain positions it believes warrant further review of the classification outcomes determined.”*

The meeting also discussed the way forward and agreed that once we receive the classifications for all positions, meetings at the workplaces will be called to determine our next course of action.

Further to my correspondence to you dated 26 September 2008, I write to update you in relation to the Central Northern Adelaide Health Service (CNAHS) Medical Imaging Submission (which included Royal Adelaide Hospital, Lyell McEwin Hospital and The Queen Elizabeth Hospital), received on 7 July 2008 and the submission for Breast Screen SA (BSSA), received on 3 October 2008.

In relation to the submission received 7 July 2008, the panel has assessed all positions.

The panel met last Tuesday 7 October 2008 to consider the BSSA submission and completed its assessment of most of the positions. A further meeting is scheduled for this afternoon when it is expected that the remaining BSSA positions will be completed. I will phone you to confirm this following the meeting.
