Public sector workers showed their unity

What an amazing show of strength and solidarity showing by thousands of public sector workers, community members, politicians from the minor parties and some Labor back benches (yes! some Labor back benches) at yesterday's march against the Government's Legislative Attack on Public Sector Workers and Budget Cuts. This has been the biggest march/rally so far in the unions' campaign against Rann and Foley's.

The march assembled at Victoria Square, marched through the streets of Adelaide. The traffic came to a standstill along King William Street and North Terrace in front of Parliament House where the march ended. Various speakers encouraged participants to continue the campaign in order save jobs, services, employment entitlements and conditions.

Currently, the Legislative Council is debating the Budget Legislation during this week sitting of parliament. Family First and the Greens are attempting to make amendments to the Budget Bill; with the aim of saving jobs, services and employment conditions. The debate is expected to continue for the remainder of this week. Members are encouraged to contact your local member of parliament to express your concerns.
